

Capacity Building Programme - ‘Preservation of Historical and Cultural Monuments

A 12-day Capacity Building Programme on ‘Preservation of Historical and Cultural Monuments’, from 06th March to 17th March 2023, was organized by the Department of Museology, National Museum Institute in collaboration with the Ministry of External Affairs for in-service museum professionals of the Mekong-Ganga Cooperation (MGC) partner countries. Museum professionals and conservators from Cambodia, Laos, Thailand, and Vietnam participated in the training programme. The program was organized under the supervision of Prof (Dr.) Manvi Seth, Dean, HOD (Museology), NMI, and Asst. Prof (Dr.) Juhi Sadiya, Department of Museology.

As part of the Capacity Building Programme, a series of lectures were organised on the Meaning of Heritage, Disaster Management, Prevention against Illicit Trafficking of Cultural Properties, Conservation and Management etc., and guided tours of principal monuments in and around Delhi: Humayun’s Tomb, Qutub Minar, Tughlaqabad fort, Red Fort, Delhi, and Taj Mahal, Agra, were conducted accompanied by onsite lectures by renowned scholars.
