1. About NSSTA

National Statistical Systems Training Academy (NSSTA), then National Academy of Statistical Administration (NASA) under Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), came into being on 13th February, 2009 for imparting training on Official Statistics and related disciplines and undertaking associated research activities. Its mandate includes imparting training in the field of “Official Statistics” to the statistical personnel, not only of the Central and State/UTs Governments of the country but also of the developing countries in the Asia Pacific region.



The training programmes are meant for different target Groups viz. fresh recruits and in-service officers of Indian Statistical Service (ISS), Subordinate Statistical Service (SSS), State Governments Statistical Personnel; M. Stat. Students of Indian Statistical Institute; UG/PG students and Professors of Statistics of different Universities; International Participants; International Students of International Statistical Education Centre (ISEC); SAARC participants and need based/ request based statistical training for State Officials and other developing countries.

The Academy has been well established over 8 Acre area and has three main blocks as follows:

- **Academic Block** – Teaching cum administration block having 4 Lecture halls with a total capacity of 110 participants, One Conference hall with digital interactive Board and Display LED having capacity of around 60 persons, Assembly hall at ground floor having capacity of 100 persons and Auditorium for 150 persons.



- **Sukhatme Library** is IT enabled and the database is maintained in Libsys10. About 23,400 books have been maintained in Libsys. Further, Sukhatme Library is also a member of the largest library network viz. DELNET.

- **Hostel Block** – NSSTA has a full-fledged hostel facility inside the campus having 40 single, 30 double bedded AC rooms with attach bath as well as 6 VIPs suites/Guest Rooms for faculty/Guest.
- Hostel block having common canteen and air-conditioned dining hall, common lounge with TV Studio alongwith Laundry Room with fully automatic Washing Machines.



Residential Block - NSSTA has a total number of 20 residential quarters for the officials working/posted at NSSTA.

Sports-facilities for Trainees

- Indoor Games like Billiard, Chess, Carom board, Table Tennis;
- Outdoor Games like Badminton, Basket Ball and Volley Ball with flood lights;
- Fully equipped Yoga centre with the facility of a trainer and a multi-Gymnasium.



2. Proposal

The Mekong-Ganga Cooperation (MGC) is an initiative by six countries – India and five ASEAN countries, namely, Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand and Vietnam for cooperation in tourism, culture, education, as well as transport and communications. MGC initiative aims to facilitate closer contacts among the people inhabiting these six countries. The MGC is also indicative of the cultural and commercial linkages among the member countries of the MGC down the centuries.

2. The Mekong Ganga Cooperation (MGC) had finalized a Plan of Action (2019-2022) in 2019 which extended up to 2025 covering broad elements of cooperation under various areas.

3. The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation was approached by Ministry of External Affairs on ways to implement the following action point (contained in the Plan of Action) with respect to MGC Countries i.e Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand and Vietnam:

“Organizing training and scholarship programs on National Accounts Statistics and large-scale socio-economic sample surveys”.

3. Accordingly, two-week training on National Accounts Statistics and large-scale socio-economic sample surveys” was organized by National Statistical Systems Training Academy (NSSTA) during 11th March to 22nd March, 2024.

3. Objective

The two-week training programme was intended to given the exposure of (a) Overview of National Accounts Statistics in India, Data Sources and Methodology of Compilation of National Accounts, Sequence of Accounts with emphasis on Production accounts, Supply & Use Table and Compilation of Regional accounts and of (b) Overview of Large Scale Socio-Economic Sample Surveys, Concept and Definitions, Designing of Survey Instruments, Sample Design and Estimation Procedure, Household Surveys, Collection of Information, Urban Frame Survey, Discussion on Annual Survey of Industries and Quality Management Tools and Concept, Definition, Data Processing, Tabulation & method of Estimation along with hands on experience on each topic.

4. Training Delivery

As planned, the training programme was attended by all the 20 participants, 5 each from Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar and Vietnam. List of participants is attached at Annexure-I. All the participants were well received from IGI Airport New Delhi during the mid-night of 10th March and taken to NSSTA, Greater Noida where all necessary lodging and boarding arrangements were made. On 11th March, 2024, the training programme was inaugurated by Shri Sumedh S Nagrare, Additional Director General (Trg.), MoSPI in the presence of Shri Harsh Chirania, Under Secretary, MEA among others NSSTA's Officers/Staff. During the inaugural & interactions session, participants introduced themselves and interacted with other officers/faculty. They were made aware about plan of action of newt two-week and given the briefing of the training programme as well as sensitized about the available facility at NSSTA's Campus. All the training sessions were arranged by inviting senior officers of MoSPI who are real practitioners and actively working on the specific topic in India. Apart from the classroom training & hands on exercises, participants were taken to Agra and Delhi as a part of their study tour.

5. Evaluation

Group-wise country presentations of all the participants were organised at the end of each week on each of the topics of the training programme. During the presentations, participants talked about the best practices of their country of respective topic and take away from this training programme. These presentations were attended by concerned divisional heads as well as NSSTA's Officers.

6. Feedback

Feedback of participants were taken on daily basis by course team. Apart from this, formal feedback of participants was received via google sheet, copy of the same is attached at Annexure-II. Further, during the valediction programme, participants also shared their experiences and convey their regards for making all the arrangements, so well. 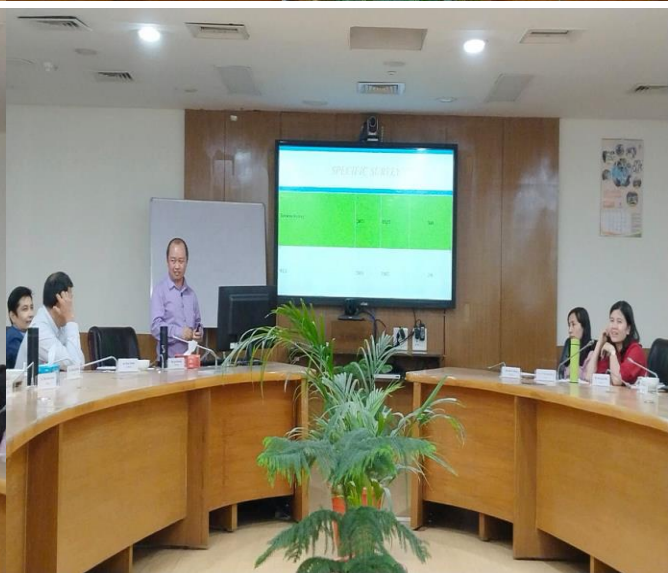
